PROJECT EYE DONATION



Last year, the Bharat Vikas Parishad, Delhi (South) embarked on a campaign for motivating members and others, to pledge their eyes after they are gone. Their eyes would benefit at least 2 persons per donor as, due to shortage of the harvested eyes, only one cornea is planted in a recipient. All Branches were requested to make sure to announce this Project in all their meetings

and other gatherings.

The effort continues and I request all the Branches and senior functionaries who address meetings from time to time to make a mention of this important project. Lectures from Eye Specialists and personnel of the Eye Banks can also be arranged to address such meetings as a normal activity. Our Branches can play a great role in this. I can offer my humble services for such meetings.

The intention is to motivate people for pledging their eyes. Let me make it clear that everyone - young & old, persons using spectacles or contact lens, those who have undergone cataract operation, those with high blood sugar, high blood pressure, etc. can pledge their eyes.

Once a person is motivated, a small form can be filled up and sent to the undersigned. It will be deposited with National Eye Bank in AIIMS, New Delhi. Up to this there is not much problem.



The problem arises when the family members forget that someone who expired had desired to donate his/her eyes. In that dark hour the family is in a state of grief and cannot call the harvesting team in time. In my meeting with the personnel of the National Eye Bank, I asked them to have a mechanism by which this difficulty can be surmounted. They could not suggest any. But during discussion something of a way out did emerge.

A beautifully designed certificate will be printed with names of the donors of a particular family inscribed therein. It will be nicely framed and given over to the donor family. The quality of this 'gift' would be such that anyone would like to put it up in his drawing room or any other prominent place in the house. Relatives, friends and other visitors in the house would see it fondly and will also be motivated. To the family members it will

serve as a constant reminder. The cost of each such 'certificate' will be around Rs. 130/-. I suggest that these certificates should be issued at Branch level

This, I believe, will be helpful to call the Eye Bank Team in the Dark Hour.

So, let us all start once again and get-set-go for this laudable Project.

On **14th July 2011** a free Dental camp was organized. 42 patients benefited from the camp.

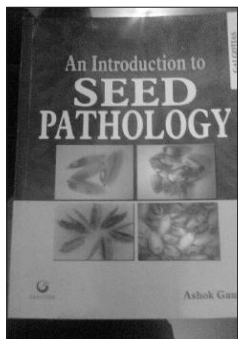

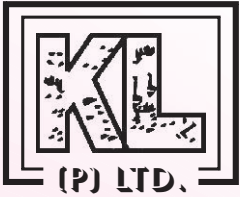
